

# **EDGE Fellows Summer Program Summary 2018**

## **Goal of the EDGE Fellows Summer Program:**

EDGE Fellows research the up-side potential for new business concepts provided by area business leaders. This program provides students with a truly entrepreneurial experience, connects them with leaders and businesses, and encourages them to keep their expertise in Northeast Ohio after graduation.

### **2018 EDGE Fellows Program:**

- 10 entrepreneurial graduate-level interns were assigned in cross-functional teams of two to study the feasibility of new business ideas from regionally-based companies.
- EDGE assigned business mentors to student teams, linked students with host companies, and connected them with industry experts to assist with their research efforts.
- Fellows addressed 5 new business opportunities projects from different industries, including a Medical Device and Diagnostic with 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> World Applications, 3D Printing & Bio-inks as well as new markets for Coatings and Paints, LED Lighting and Plastics.
